HOW IT WORKS

Survivor Ventures reimburses you \$15 per hour; 40 hours per week for the first year of employment on the following schedule:

| Months 4-6 | 50% of gross wages |
| Months 7-9 | 25% of gross wages |
| Months 10-12 | 0% of gross wages |
